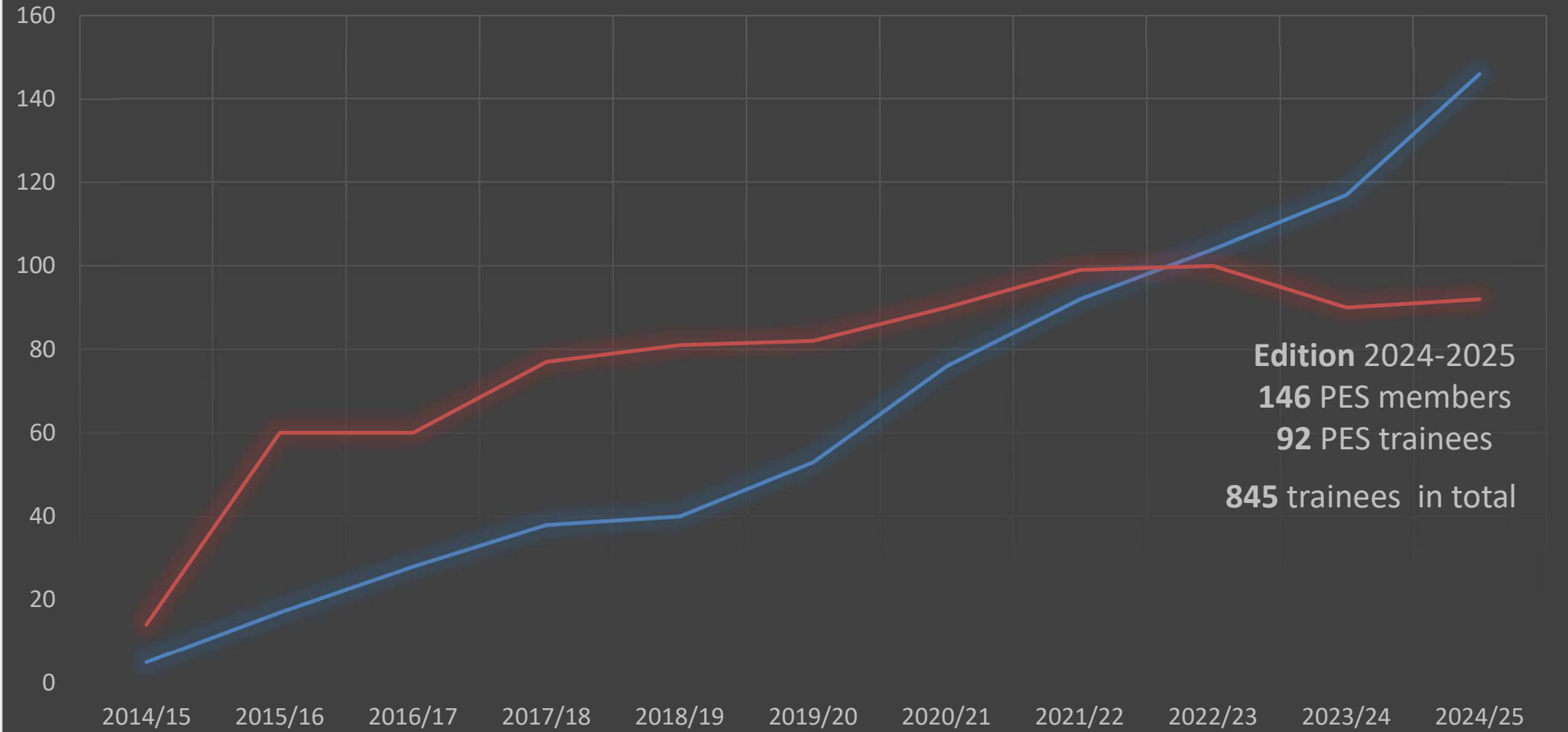

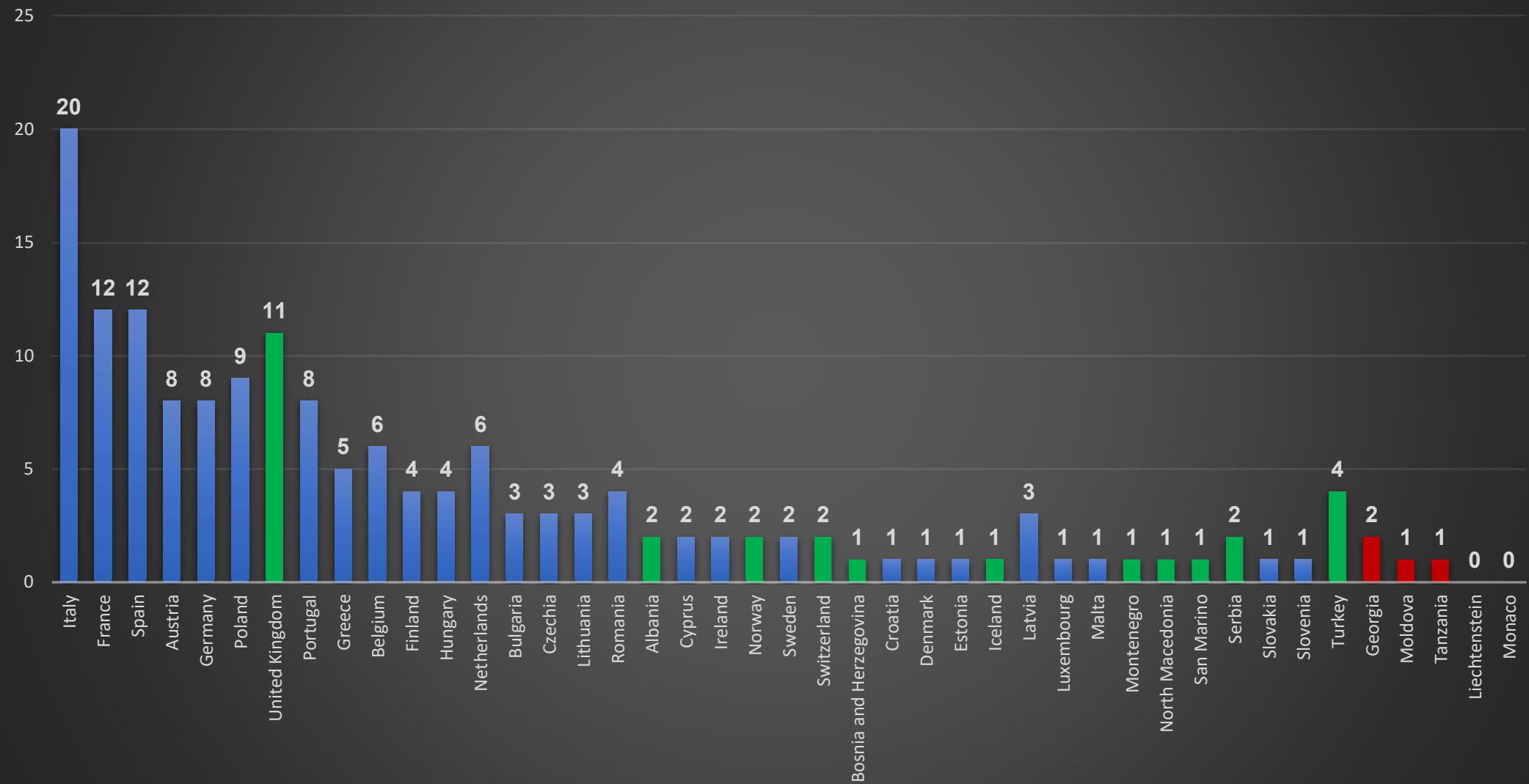

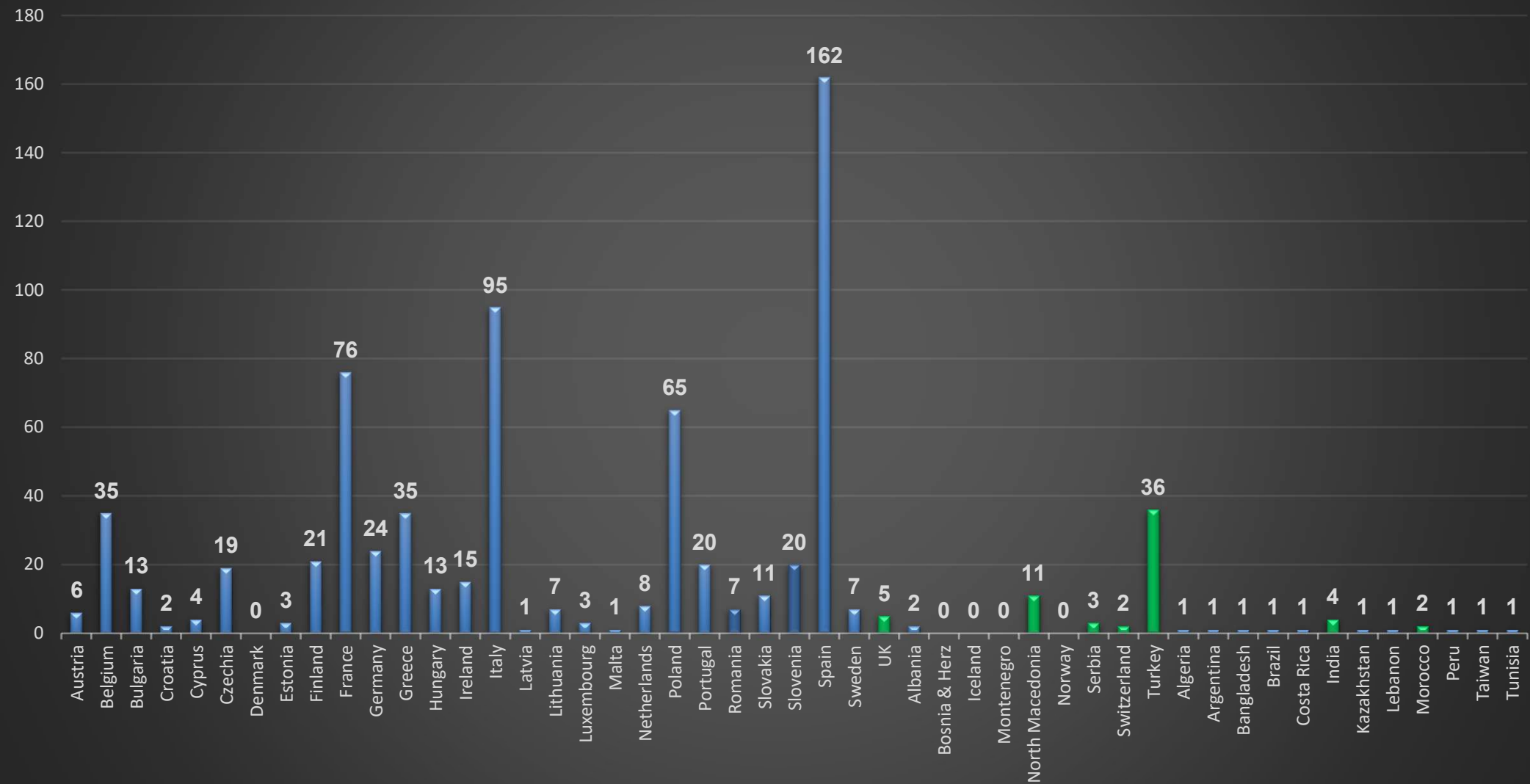

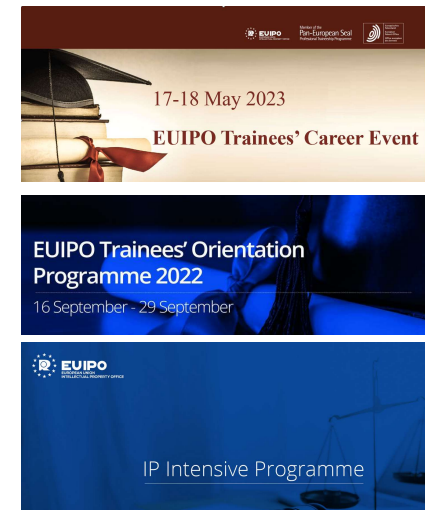

01 February 2025	Launch of the PES Traineeship Programme with the Universities
up to 28 February 2025	PES Member sends the EUIPO candidates shortlist to Pan_European_Seal@euipo.europa.eu
01 – 31 March 2025	Shortlisted candidates (only) submit their online applications through the EUIPO e-recruitment tool
01 – 30 April	Pre-selection process at EUIPO
From May until July 2025	Candidates are interviewed and selected by the EUIPO
16 September 2025	Start of the traineeship Programme at EUIPO
Until 31 December 2025	Non-selected candidates remain in Reserve List
